## Treasures on the Turnpike Event Guidelines for Vendors

1. Treasures on the Turnpike is affiliated with the National Route 50 Yard Sale which means that in addition to antiques, arts, collectibles, crafts and imports, other merchandise is eligible. Vendors will be organized according to the following categories:
  - Antiques & Collectibles
  - Health & Fitness
  - Food & Drink Vendors
  - Clothing
  - Jewelry
  - Farmers Market & Garden
  - Crafts
  - Rummage Sale Items
2. Prohibited items include animals, weapons, explicit sexual material, and personal services. Also prohibited are illegal CDs, DVDs, and other unauthorized “knock offs.”
3. Vendor spaces are listed and contracted as 200 sq ft, approx 20’ x 10’. In some cases, the space depth and width will vary, depending on the designated lot and floor plan. Displays should be flexible in order to utilize all space available to you.
4. A limited number of Tailgate spaces are available and will be assigned first come, first serve, based on receipt of fees and application.
5. All approved applicants will be e-mailed a confirmation of participation, space location, and parking location no later than May 20<sup>th</sup>. Vendors must set up in their assigned space. If not, vendors will be asked to vacate, and the registration fee will be forfeited. Vendor space is not final until payment is received.
6. Set up must be completed by 9:30am. It is recommended that vendors arrive at least by 8:00am to set up. Vendors must not vacate from their spaces until 5:00pm. Aldie enjoys a good deal of early evening traffic from tourists leaving Middleburg and driving east to the city along Route 50.
7. Vendors, other than Tailgate Vendors, will be required to unload and move their vehicles to their designated parking in the village by 9:00am.
8. Vendors must bring their own tables, chairs and tents if desired, and should also be prepared to protect themselves and their merchandise from bad weather. All spaces are outdoors and uncovered; many are without shade.
9. Historic birthday celebration in honor of Aldie’s founder (Charles Fenton Mercer) to take place on Sunday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, from 12:00 – 5:00pm at the Aldie Mill. This event will bring additional visitors to the village. Vendors may set up both days if desired. No extra fee applies.
